Music: Importance, History, Favorites It may be the universal language of mankind Old Time Music was an enjoyable part of our history.

Importance: Forms of Music were used for important signaling and in managing wildlife. It has been used as a weapon. It was used against a fugitive (Noriaga) holed up for days until he gave up as he could not sleep of stand it any longer. But mostly music was used for enjoyment and inspiration. Most people enjoy their favorite forms of music. People have been inspired to think, to write, to take action and to go into battle because of music. Music can also help put one to sleep. Music is a transporter of local and national culture.

History: Early humans discovered that things made different sounds. Of course they experimented with this. They discovered that certain devices could call animals. Eventually they discovered that sounds could be useful or fun to use. Horns, whistles, fifes, drums, bells could be used to communicate over distances. Certain patterns of sounds were later used in dances, courting and ceremonies. Later instruments were created by nearly every human culture for enjoyment.

Kinds of instruments:

Percussive instruments are those which make a sound when being struck such ad drums, bells, xylephone, trinangle, gong, harpsichord, piano, hammered dulcimer, shaped wood, metal, plastic, clay, gourd, plants or stone, .

Wind instruments are those who make a sound when air goes thru them. flute, fife, pipe organ, clarinet, tuba, trumpet, bugle, French horn, obo, whistle, recorder, harmonica, reed organ, harmonica, accordian, concertina, okrina, gourd, bone, conch shell, or plants.

String instruments are those which make a sound when a string is vibrated harp, fiddle, cello, violin, bass, viola, lute, guitar, banjo, lute, ukulele, zither

Electronic instruments are the Moog synthesiser, electronic organ, relay, hard drives, recorded and played back recorders.

Explosive cannon, tuned fireworks

Natural Human and animal voices and sounds, geographic features that make sounds from wind and water.

Music and sounds were used for communication, signaling, courting, entertainment and enjoyment. For professional musicians and entertainers it was often a well paid vocation. For some it was not. Music can inspire, trigger emotions or can irritate. Music can influence human action and there be instrumental in causing events or putting one to sleep.

Music was used in almost every culture. Islam has banned music.

In North America music was used by primitive man and later our Woodland Indians who were here when the French came here. They used music in dances and courting. Both the French and British use music in the military and to help pass away the time on long canoe trips and in camps.

Settlers sometimes brought instruments with them but often ordered them shipped to them. Of course they were busy trying to survive at first but as they got a little more free time they used music more. It provided a pastime and relaxation. Of course churches often used organs and other instruments.

The most common instruments used by the 1800-1939 farmers were: fiddles, pots, flutes, whistles, fifes, drums, concertinas, ocarinas, bells and the king of instruments the pedal organ. With exception of concertinas and organs many instruments were hand made.

When were these played? Players had to practice in their spare time and this was often a pleasant pastime. Social events like family visitations, religious meetings, holidays, fairs, barn raisings, quilting bees, harvesting bees, singins, sugar hops for young people to meet etc. Some times a local store would encourage a musician to sit nearby and play. Sunday and Wednesday church events were the most common.

In the local areas we did not see local theaters until the 1920s and later. In August of 1920 the first News was broadcast by station 8MKin Detroit, Michigan, now <u>WWJ</u>. In October 1920 2ADD (renamed <u>WRUC</u> in 1947), aired what is believed to be the first public entertainment broadcast in the United States, a series of Thursday night concerts initially heard within a 100-mile radius and later for a 1,000-mile radius. Soon music was heard through out the USA. Music of course was prominent on TV which came in in the late 1940s. While big in churches music did not find it's way into most schools until after the Civil War. Johann Pestalozzi a Swiss educator influenced Lowell Mason, a Boston church musician who convinced a Boston School Committee to allow him to introduce music into the curriculum at the Hawes School in Boston in the fall of 1837. This concert convinced the school committee that music should part of school curriculum. All over the USA town bands were popping up and in rural areas sometimes there were farmers bands. My Uncle Danial Stewart wrote about it in his farmers diary in the late 1800s.

John Dewey wrote a treatise in 1916 that he called "Democracy in Education". Dewey's fundamental philosophy was grounded on the concept of child centered education. This led to more music instruction in public schools.

By the 1920s many schools were offering some music education. Families who really cherished music also bought instruments and hired tutors. Such as Ms Wright in Warren Village.

The first Teacher that I have located was Homer Hazelton who led the 1929 Busch Band in 1929. St clement school had a band. My mother played in a community band in Warren and Center line in the early 1940s.

Alton C Powell was a band leader in Center Line.

Later D Maria and J Koler.

Leonard Schimm was band director at Fitzgerald Schools in 1980s.

Jeff Cotter was a band director at Warren consolidated and later led the Warren Symphony.

Music has been a part of Human culture for thousands of years. It has been enjoyable to most people in its many

forms around the world. It most likely evolved with the human species in Africa and spread around the world. Music is influenced by culture, climate, access to technology but most of all by human emotions. Music first probably imitated sounds found in the surrounding nature such as bird calls and progressed into folk, classical, country, pop, electronic and all other forms we experience today. **The history of music is best heard.** The settlers of our area probably did not hear much native American music and they later acquired instruments and music from their native lands.

Common instruments of the past were: First of all the human voice.

The native materials around them allowed them to create instruments.

At first hollow gourds could be formed into ocarina like instruments and long plants formed into flute like instruments. Larger plants combined with skins were made into drums.

Strings could be formed from natural materials and animal parts and stretched over hollow openings to form dulcimer or violin like instruments or over drums to form banjo like instruments. As our area was largely settled in the middle 1800s craftsmen had already created fine examples of the classical instruments we now know. The most common of course was the fiddle, pump organ, fife, concertina, forms of lap harps.



The harmonica was invented in Vienna before 1824 but few showed up in America until around the time of the Civil War. It was a pocket instrument, inexpensive and easy to play. President Lincoln carried a harmonica in his pocket. The Red Cross gave them out to troops in WWII.

Of course the instrument we hear most about is fiddle. It was a challenging instrument to play. But it was the only

instrument in the family.









The Guitar was a late comer but became a folk favorite instrument.

There were many other instruments used in the old days. Some were hand made or bought by mail order.

The all time best and most versatile instrument has been the organ. Prior to electricity they had to be pumped by foot power. The music had a wide range. Many a home in the 1800s had pump organs. Big like this one or

Above you see a Jamaica eye which was a vacuum tube which looked like an eye and changed its appearance with the power of the radio signal. It was used to tune the radio to the best signal.

Above left you see an early radio set called a crystal radio because it used a piece of crystalline mineral such as galena which acted as a diode separating the audio signal from the radio frequency signal. These sets used just the power of the radio waves. They needed no batteries. You tuned it by sliding a slider across a coil of wire. You had to string a long antenna as far and as high as you could to trap the signals. These radios actually worked and one could listen to a few stations.

There are some things that need to be put into print for the sake of our younger generation who need to know about them but often don't. Here they are:

American Way of Life

America was to millions both the hope and a dream come true. People came here from many countries where many (but not all) had been oppressed, many had lived in poverty, did not have freedom.
