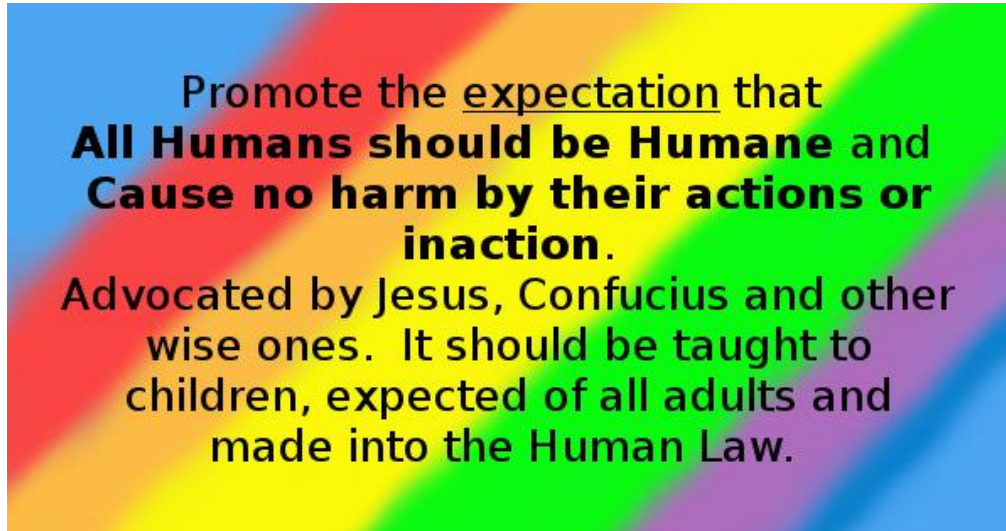

Roger S. Laske; A Short Autobiography St Clement thru 8th grade

I was born in Detroit in 1940. My mother and I next moved to Hamtramck to live with my maternal grandmother while my dad was in the Army in WWII. Our next moved was to an upper flat in Detroit in 1943 near the City Airport. I had been attending Holy Name Elementary School a few blocks south of McNichols (6 Mile Rd) at Van Dyke Avenue.

My parents, Chester and Stephanie Laske, moved to Center Line late in 1948 with my sister Patricia and me. They purchased a house on Edward Street, just east of the cross-street, Automobile. I completed my second grade at St. Clement Grade School and attended St. Clement through the 8th grade, which was in the “new” St. Clement School.

I attended De La Salle Collegiate High School in Detroit, then located near Detroit City Airport, near Connor & Gratiot Streets. There were two other students that attended DLS from Edward Street, Jerry Radlinski and Jim Martin. Before I got my Driver’s License, there were a few others from the Center Line area that drove us to school, notably Peter Tranchida, Donald Groesbeck and Roger Schoenherr. While attending high school, I worked at the Mobil gas station on the corner of Van Dyke and Gronow, washing cars by hand. When I turned 16, I was legally able to pump gas for the customers. The gas station was owned by Bob Brinker & Carl Rutley and was previously owned by Hank Gietzen. In 1957 Carl Rutley bought the Standard Gas Station on the NE corner of Van Dyke & Central Streets so I went with him then. Fortunately, my girlfriend, Jean Skavery, lived just down the street.

I attended the University of Detroit School of Engineering, majoring in Architecture for the years 1958 to

1960. In the summers of 1958 through 1960, I worked at the Chrysler Missel Plant doing electrical schematic drawings and Federal Department Store on 7 Mile & Gratiot. In September 1961 I married a St. Clement girl, Jean Skavery at the “New” St. Clement Church, being the first marriage at the church. We then moved into the Kramer Homes Coop on 10 Mile Road in Center Line.

I had quit college at U of D and started a job at Fisher Body Division of General Motors at the newly opened GM Tech Center as an Engineering Illustrator. My job included creating assembly drawings, visual slide presentations, and traveling to the GM Assembly plants to facilitate their Pilot or Start-Up programs. I returning to college at Wayne State University at nights, obtaining my Bachelor’s Degree in Fine Arts, majoring in Design. I was promoted through the years at GM to Engineering Group Manager, retiring in 1992 after 32 years.

After retiring for a year, one of my old vendor shops called me as they needed someone to interface with Mercedes Benz in Stuttgart, Germany. I did this for about two years, retiring again in 1996. But being retired did not mean that I did not keep busy. In 1989 I bought a classic 1956 Chevrolet and joined the Oakland County Classic Chevy Club, eventually publishing the Club newsletter. I also had joined the Polish Genealogical of Michigan (PGSM) in 1991, and joined their Board of Directors in 1996. In 2006 I became the Editor of their journal, “Polish Eaglet.” I did this for 15 years, editing, researching, and writing many articles. I visited family in Poland five times; the first time in 2002 when my mother took me to meet them. I made trips in 2008 and 2011 exploring Poland and neighboring countries after my Polish families. In 2014 and 2016 I took my oldest daughter to meet the family and show her the wonderful sites of our Polish Heritage.

Early on, he had one of the most unique jobs, and a highly visible one at that. The village needed someone to tend its gasoline street lamps and Mr. Licht was its “Lamp Lighter” for as long as he was needed. We probably have forgotten that early lamps were filled with gasoline at the base and were lighted manually by a long pole with a trigger device. This required the lighter to go to each lamp at dusk to ignite it and at daylight to extinguish it (filling the base as needed). He is believed to have been the Village’s only lighter, but it was not his only job. He went into politics and was elected Township Justice of the Peace in 1914 as a starter. He drew upon his past public exposure then and was elevated to Township Supervisor in 1926 and swept away the competition for six succeeding elections. Not yet finished with public life, he then won election as Township Treasurer for five terms, leaving office finally in 1941 when Frank

Wiegand took over. It was during Frank Licht's tenure as supervisor that residential growth was such that private wells along Van Dyke (such as one the Groesbeck family built and had extended down several streets from Studebaker and Van Dyke) were abandoned and the area connected to the Detroit system.
