Children's Stones at St Clement Cemetery with cause of death if known

Before medical advances prior to World War Two there were often 2-4 times the number of children who died young than adults. Hundreds children buried here perhaps most have no stone. Because stilborns and day old babies were rarely marked with a stone and often not mentioned in records there are many more children buried in old cemeteries than stones show. For example here are the first two burials both children but where are they buried where is the stone?
